

## OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY (OHSAS)

### STATEMENT

Valco Consulting Ltd will ensure the health, safety and welfare of all employee's and other persons who may be affected by the works of Valco Consulting Ltd.

- Provision and maintenance of a safe means of access to and egress from all workplaces as out offices or on sites where we are the Principal Contractor.
- Prevention of incidents resulting in personal injury, property damage and cases of work-related ill health.
- The safety of; and absence of risks to health in connection with the use, handling, storage, transportation and disposal of materials and substances.
- Provision of such information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure that work may be carried out safely, either at Springwood, Booths Park, Chelford Road, Knutsford. WA16 8GS or on projects without risks to health.
- Reviewing and revising this policy at regular intervals not exceeding annually.

Employees and sub-contractors have a duty to co-operate in the operation of this policy by fulfilling the responsibilities placed upon them.

Valco Consulting Ltd recognises the need for continual improvement and through discussion and staff liaison. We will target and maintain the objective of Zero Harm.

As stated, the operations of the company and this policy will be reviewed at regular intervals or in light of changing company circumstances, procedures and legislation.
